***August 2, 2010 Child Care Business Basics: Fee of \$40.00 due by July 29, 2010** (30 credit hours) You must attend all 10 parts to receive credit. This training is for individuals who are interested in starting, expanding, strengthening and/or running their child care business successfully. ***August 5, 2010 Developmentally Appropriate Behavior: But, I'm supposed to act like this: Fee of \$5.00 due by July 29, 2010** (2 credit hours) This training focuses on understanding when children can be expected to acquire certain social emotional skills and guides participants toward understanding, respecting and responding to developmentally appropriate behaviors.

***August 24, 2010 Inclusion: Working Together, A Focus on Families: Fee of \$5.00 due by August 17, 2010** (2 credit hours) When the child care program & family communicate regularly about a child's accomplishments and needs, the child will be more likely to reach his or her developmental potential. This training explores how providers can utilize professional behavior to understand a family's personal circumstances, experiences, culture, concerns, priorities, and resources in order to better help the child.
