


- * This required training explains all the parts of North Carolina's SIDS Law. Participants will review information about when and how to use the approved waivers, how to best place a baby in bed to sleep, and other "Best Practice" recommendations. During the workshop, participants will get the needed information to create a Safe Sleep Policy, updated research about SIDS, and local health and safety resources. Participants also will be walked through how to do an unresponsive infant drill and the reason for doing them regularly.



* Children cope differently to crises than adults as they lack the life experiences and skills to make meaning of the event without support from caregivers and the community. Children take cues on how to respond to an emergency from their teachers and caregivers, yet often times these care providers are personally affected by the crisis themselves, forcing them to juggle the many responsibilities as stress levels go up. In this training, learn how trauma effects children, children's common reactions to crises and best practices to facilitate their short- and long-term emotional recovery. Learn about and discuss methods for caring for yourself as a caregiver so you can effectively support the recovery of the children and families you serve.


- * This training discusses playground safety techniques as well as equipment regulations. Participants will travel to a nearby child care facility to complete a mock playground safety inspection.






- * Death and loss is a part of life that affects young children. The emotional pain of a child who has lost a loved one makes it tempting to avoid the subject or to try to distract the child. When a loss is not addressed appropriately by adults it may leave the child feeling confused or promote a feeling of distrust. While we would all like to shield children from grief, the reality is that they will all experience it at one time or another. This session will define most common times of grief and loss for young children, identify stages of grief, discover ways young children react behaviorally to grief and loss, and determine ways to support children through this process.


- * Stress is a fact of life, no matter your age. Some stress is good for us – it keeps us attentive, sharp, productive, and learning. But Toxic Stress affects brain development and learning in young children, and can have long-lasting effects. This session will help participants define stress responses and understand the difference between “tolerable” and “toxic” stress. We’ll look at the long term effects of Toxic Stress and investigate practices for mitigating those effects and promoting resilience in young children.


- * Everything in a baby's world happens in steps and stages. It is important to appreciate each stage as it occurs and provide the support and guidance needed to allow a successful journey through each one. This training will offer suggestions of what types of materials support learning at the different stages. You will gain insight on the benefits of providing babies with ample time and space to master a skill before moving on to start practicing a new one and will explore some of the drawbacks of intervening unnecessarily. With each mastered skill, babies are discovering more about their bodies, the world around them and how the two work together. These skills are the foundations that they will carry with them throughout their life and across all domains of learning. This training provides information that supports the ITERS -R subscales: Space and Furnishings, Activities and Program structure.

Online Training Guidelines

Registration

Registrations must be filled out and sent to Venus@cravensmartstart.org to be enrolled into a training. Registration will end 48 business hours before each training so that Venus and the training staff can adequately prepare for the training.

The registration form is attached at the end of our training calendar and is the only registration form used for Craven Smart Start trainings.

Each participant must have their own individual email and personal phone number listed. All correspondence is being completed through email and phone. It is important to have your personal email and phone number so that each participant can be individually contacted.

We will not be able to accept registration forms from providers at the same location using the facility phone number and/or email.

The demographic survey, pre-survey, and possible pre-assessment (depending on the training) must be completed BEFORE the evening of the training. If your demographic survey and pre-work is not submitted, you will not be allowed to attend the evening of the training. Without this requirement being met, certificates of completion may not be given.

Training Attendance

Our training policy states that a minimum of 5 individuals must enroll for a class to be held. If we do not have at least 5 participants at the 48-business hour cut off time, the training will be closed.

Our trainings have limited number of spaces. Once our maximum capacity has been filled, we stop enrollment for that training. Please register early to ensure your space.

If you are unable to attend the training, you will need to notify Venus Miller. We will be unable to substitute participants.


