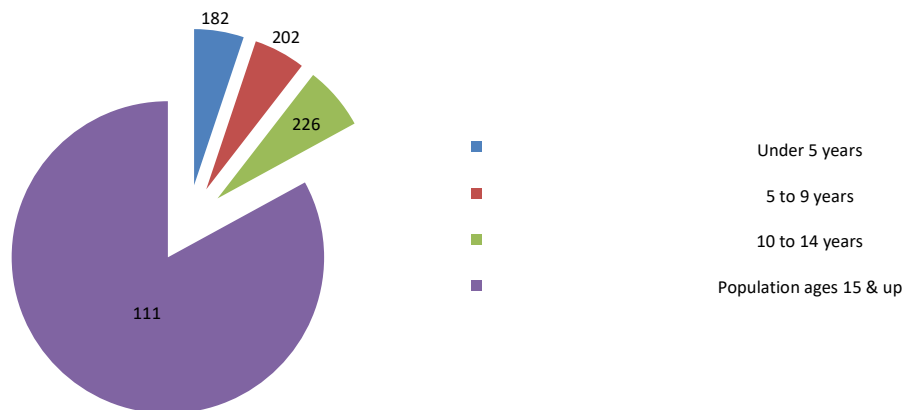

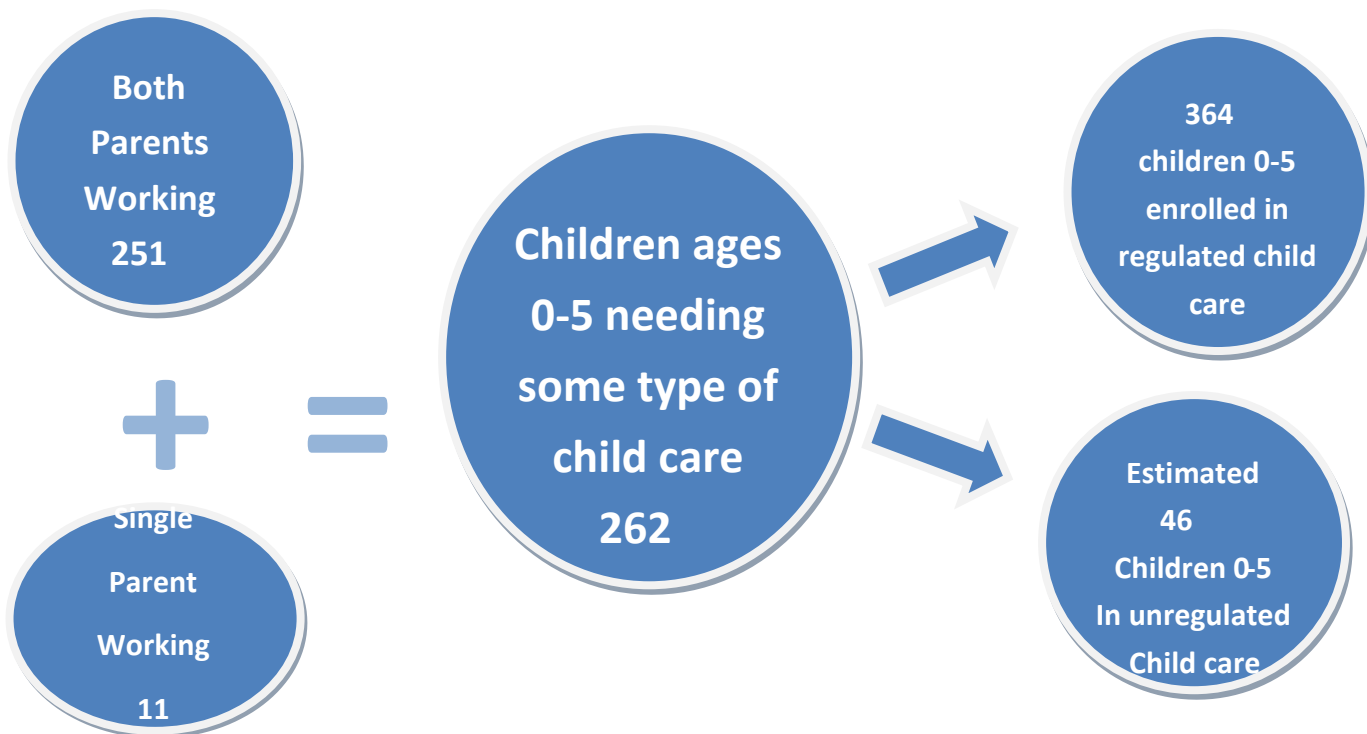
How many children live in Tyrrell County?



Tyrrell County Population: 9,590

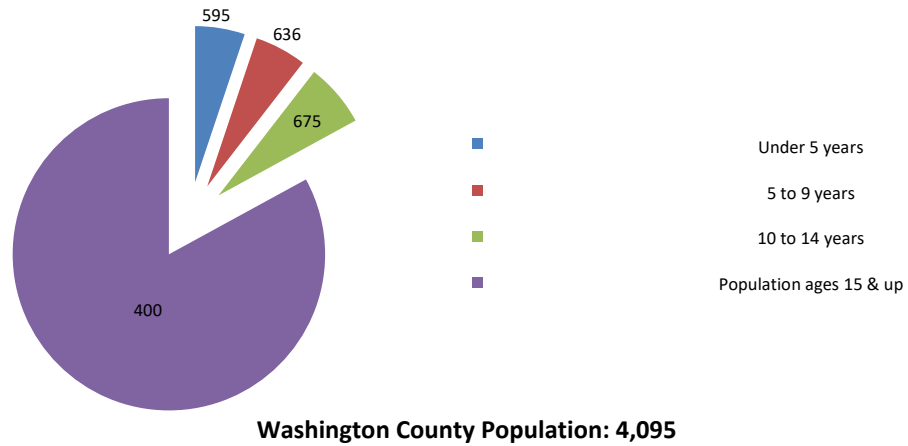

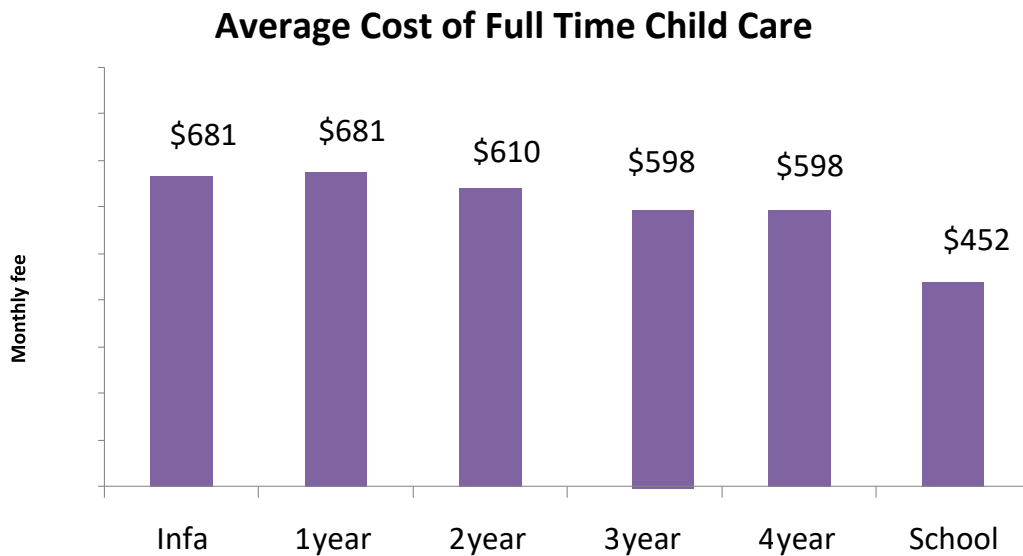
How many children live in Washington County?

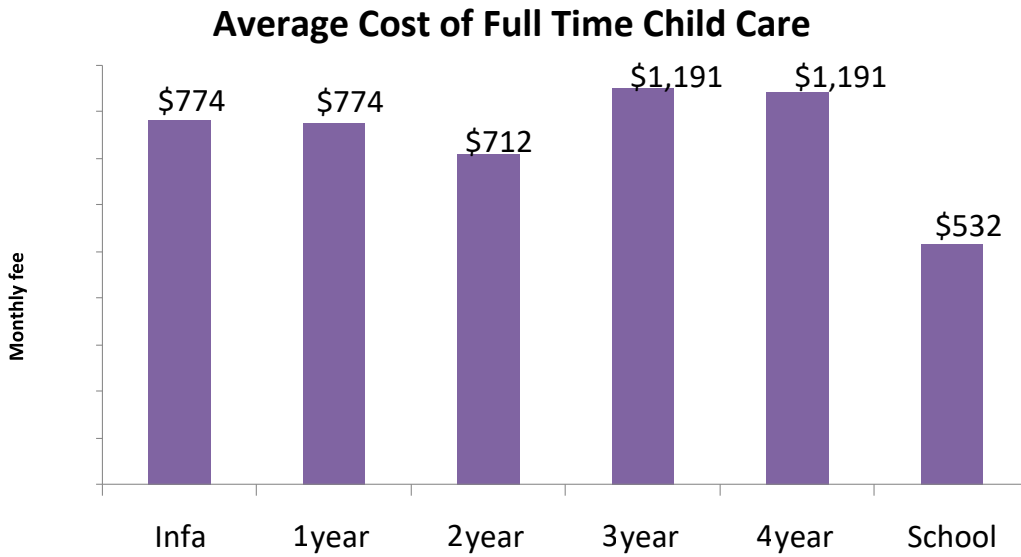

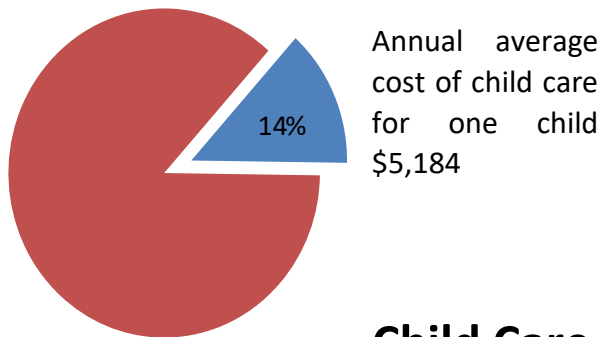
How much does child care cost in Washington County?

Tyrrell County Median Income \$35,300

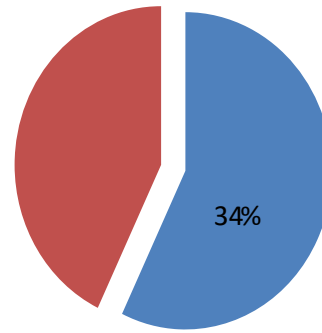


Child Care Cost as Portion of Minimum Wage Income

Full-time minimum wage income \$15,080

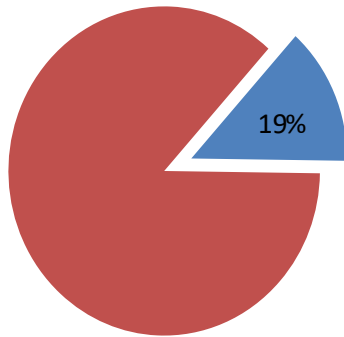

Child Care Cost as Portion of Median Income

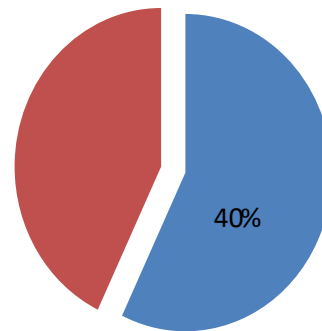

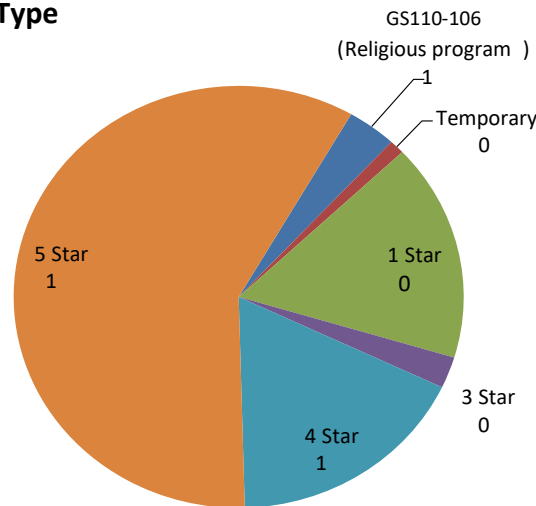

What is the quality of child care available in Tyrrell County?

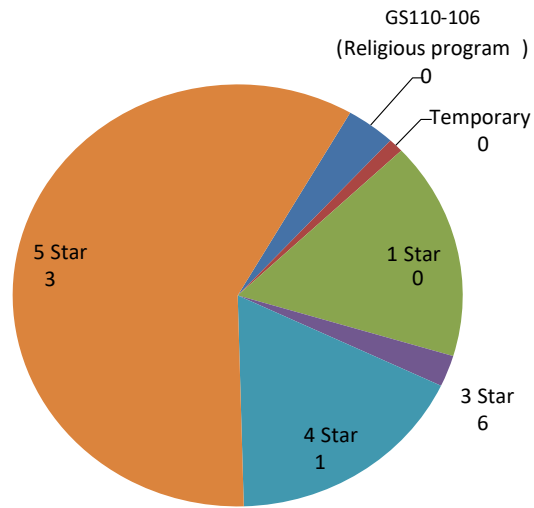
Licensed Daytime Slots
